

Masks	Physical Distancing
 Required indoors for staff and students. Recommended when outdoors. Mask breaks during lunch and 5 mins., every hour. Mask exemptions per ADA. 	 Aiming for 3 ft between students. 6 ft between staff. Virtual faculty meetings.
Daily Health Screening	Personal Hygiene
 Students screened daily per ECDOH. Staff will complete a daily health screening electronically before entering the school. 	Students and staff are encouraged to properly wash their hands throughout the day. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes are readily available for all.
COVID-19 Testing	COVID-19 Vaccinations
Voluntary testing may become available for staff and students. Further details will follow.	Vaccinations are recommended for all eligible individuals as a means of ensuring a safe and continuous educational program.
Cohorts	Transportation
 Elementary levels will use cohorts when possible. Middle and high school levels will typically use period scheduling. 	Transportation is the responsibility of the home school district.
Quarantine	Returning to School Following Illness
E1B will work with ECDOH to determine close contacts for quarantine purposes.	Returning from COVID-19-Like Illness: One of the following must be met for individuals to return following illness, regardless of vaccination:
*Vaccinated individuals are not subject to quarantine. <u>Unvaccinated Students</u> may be subject to quarantine if exposed to a positive individual within 3 ft or 15 minutes over 24-hours.	 A negative COVID-19 test. A note from a medical professional with an alternative diagnosis. There have been at least 10 days since the onset of COVID-19 symptoms.
Unvaccinated Staff may be subject to quarantine if exposed to a positive individual within 6 ft for 15 minutes over 24-hours. Seating charts will be maintained for tracing purposes.	Returning from COVID-19 Positive Case: All criteria must be met to return to school following testing positive for COVID-19: 1. 10 days after symptom onset or 10 days from the first positive test and,
Options for remote learning will be provided to students placed in quarantine. For tech support, parents should email istech@e1b.org .	 Fever-free for at least 24 hours without medicine. COVID-19 symptoms are improving. At-home COVID-19 tests are not acceptable.
Cleaning and Disinfection	Ventilation
All classrooms and buildings will be cleaned each day. High touch areas will be disinfected more frequently.	Schools will follow all current ventilation protocols including mechanical and natural ventilation where appropriate.
